APPLICATIONS AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS MUST BE SUBMITTED NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, MAY 3, 2024.

- Complete Apprenticeship Program Application Form**
- Copy of a Valid Driver's License, State ID, or Birth Certificate**
Upon program start, driver's license is required
- Copy of High School Transcripts or GED certificate**
- Copy of High School Attendance Record**
- One (1) Letter of Recommendation from a Teacher, Guidance Counselor, or Employer**
Can be former if recent graduate or GED recipient

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In order to enroll in the Construction Craft Laborer Apprenticeship Program, you must meet the following requirements:

HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES

- Must be between 18 and 21 years of age on July 1
- Must be a Cleveland Metropolitan School District (CMSD) high school graduate
- Must have a satisfactory attendance rate
- Must have a letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, or employer

GED RECIPIENTS

- Must be between 18 and 21 years of age on July 1
- Must have last attended a CMSD school prior to receiving GED
- Must have a letter of recommendation from a former teacher, guidance counselor, or employer

All applicants must have a valid Driver's License by the program start date

Candidates admitted to the Department of Public Utilities Construction Craft Laborer Apprenticeship Program are initially employed as a Student Assistant. After successfully completing the requirements to become an Apprentice, candidates are employed as Construction Craft Laborer Apprentices. After successfully completing the Program, Apprentices are employed as a full-time Sewer Service Worker with the City of Cleveland Division of Water Pollution Control.
