This letter is to notify you that effective January 1, 2025, there will be changes to the Division of Water Pollution Control sewer permit, inspection, and plan review fees as authorized by Board of Control Resolution Number 297-24:

ATTENTION! LICENSED SEWER BUILDERS & CONTRACTORS

Issuance of permits:

In the event that the licensed sewer builder is not present to apply for and purchase the sewer permit, a letter of authorization must be submitted by the authorized representative. The letter must contain the following:

- 1- Company letterhead
- 2- Date of letter
- 3- Authorization, Name of authorized representative
- 4- Location of work being performed
- 5- Signature of licensed sewer builder

Payment of permits:

The accepted payment options to purchase sewer permits are cash, credit/debit card, and check. Checks received must state licensed builder's company name, address, and phone number. Under no circumstances will a check be accepted without proper information being provided.

Schedule of sewer connection permit fees:

The schedule for sewer connections, as authorized by the Board of Control Resolution 297-24, is as follows:

Bulkhead Permit	\$ 114
Repair Permit	\$ 578
Extend Permit	\$ 858
Lay Permit	\$ 763
Temporary Sanitary Discharge Permit	\$ 858
Temporary Storm Discharge Permit	\$ 414
Re-Inspection	\$ 425

Permits/Inspection:

- 1- A sewer permit from the Division of Water Pollution Control (WPC) must be obtained before an excavation is made.
- 2- All plans and sewer permits required from the Division of Water Pollution Control shall be kept at the site of the work at all times while the work is in progress; this is in accordance with the City of Cleveland codified ordinances, section 541.05 (2F). **No exceptions.**
- 3- No sewer permit will be approved and the work accepted without an inspection of the exterior and the interior of the pipe. A sewer connection must be thoroughly inspected by an inspector from the Division of Water Pollution Control.
- 4- Requests for inspections must be made before 3:30 P.M. for new and old construction.
