Dear Resident,

This letter is to inform you that the City of Cleveland, Division of Water Pollution Control will undertake a project to provide an added level of protection against flooding in the Baltic Road area in the City of Cleveland. The **Baltic Road Area Sewer Project** is scheduled to commence on January 2, 2025. Starting on Baltic Road, the project consists of replacing approximately 2,000 feet of sewer on Baltic Road between West 106 Street and West Boulevard, replacing approximately 1,000 feet of sewer on West 102 Street between Clifton Boulevard and Baltic Road, replacing approximately 570 feet of sewer on Nanford Road between West 102 Street and Baltic Road, and replacing approximately 1,000 feet of sewer on West 103 Street between Clifton Boulevard and Baltic Road.

The City of Cleveland has contracted with Terrace Constructing, Inc. to perform this work. The City of Cleveland will work with the contractor and you to insure minimum inconvenience during the construction period. The contractor will install barricades within the limits of the construction area. The sewer excavation will take approximately 4 months to complete. The pavement will be restored in the trench area and the street will be resurfaced within the limits of work in the spring of 2025. We ask for your cooperation in observing all traffic regulations and following any detour signs.
